

AUSTRALIANS ARE WORRIED

Australians find it concerning or very concerning...

82% That females are **paid less** than male colleagues for the same work

78% When male colleagues **interrupt** and **talk over** female colleagues

77% When friends share **sexist jokes** on social media

70% When male colleagues make **comments** about female colleagues' sexual attractiveness

70% When women have to do all the **cleaning up** after dinner while the men watch TV

Only **14%**
